Beginning Studies in Hebrew by Dorothy Rainey

(Dorothy is a CGM Board Member and has studied Hebrew for three years.)

The first letter in the Hebrew alphabet is: **Alef:** א Alef (also Aleph) is representative of His (God's) name: Man of Sorrow. The scripture reference is, Isaiah 53:3.

Alef is also symbolic of strong /or leading

All Christians know the Holy Bible with the King James Version /translation was written or transcribed from the original Hebrew language. However, our Bible, which is based on the Hebrew language, may not be understood from its rich roots. I will be introducing you to the Hebrew alphabet which will be a primer or beginning to enhance your Christian roots and to understand some fundamental principles of our faith and relationship with God, the Father.

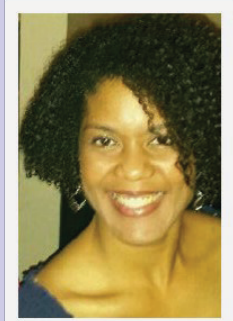
The Hebrew language is considered a Holy Language, because it is the “language of God.” Each letter of the alphabet is a direct reference to Jesus, the Christ—with names, titles and description of His Messianic personality.

“In your patience, possess ye your souls.” Luke 21:29

(Cassie Wright is a CGM Board Member. She presented a teachable moment on her Facebook page, October 7, 2016. Following is an edited transcript of the Bible teaching.)



Luke, a Gentile Christian, wrote this scripture, Luke 21:29. Luke was not a man entitled to the rights of being a child of God by the blood of Jesus because Jesus was a Jew. Luke's right was through the adoption of the faith. In many cases, this is our stance as well, many of us, are not Jewish. It is not through that physical Jewish blood that we have the right to this relationship of salvation but rather through the acceptance of Jesus as our Lord and Savior.

Luke was also a physician, educated, intelligent and a Greek man. Greeks had a wide culture, loved beauty, rhetoric, and philosophy. It was this educated people to whom Luke spoke. The Book of Luke is aimed to present Christ as the ideal, perfect man to the Greeks. He deals with the humanity of Jesus, our impulses, our desires, our wants to react and respond in a way that we might regret or have to apologize for later. This Olivet Discourse of Prophecy also known as the Little Apocalypse, found in Luke 21, includes warnings to Jesus' followers that they would suffer tribulation and persecution. When I say followers, I am talking about all of us. There is something in all of us that draws us to do right by men and for men. I believe that drawing comes from God because we come from God, we come from Christ and we can't help but want to justify this drive for righteousness not just for ourselves but for the sake and well-being of others - to defend the poor, uphold justice, to have a voice, a position, a stance, and to intentionally justify our actions and behavior in support of or opposition to a situation, or circumstance and statement of opinion or fact. And in most cases, when we are compelled to respond, we do not take the time to weigh our words or our actions. And this is exactly what Luke is pointing to in this statement. He says, “In your patience possess ye your souls.”

So, I just want to encourage you guys today, don't let anything or anyone push you over the edge to say or do anything you're going to have to regret later or feel the need to apologize for later.

So, be patient and possess ye your souls.

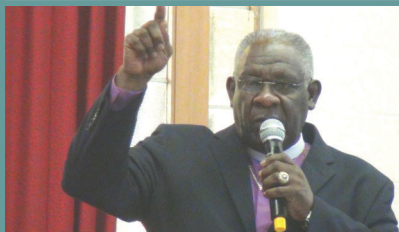

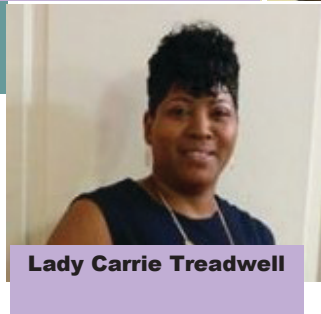
